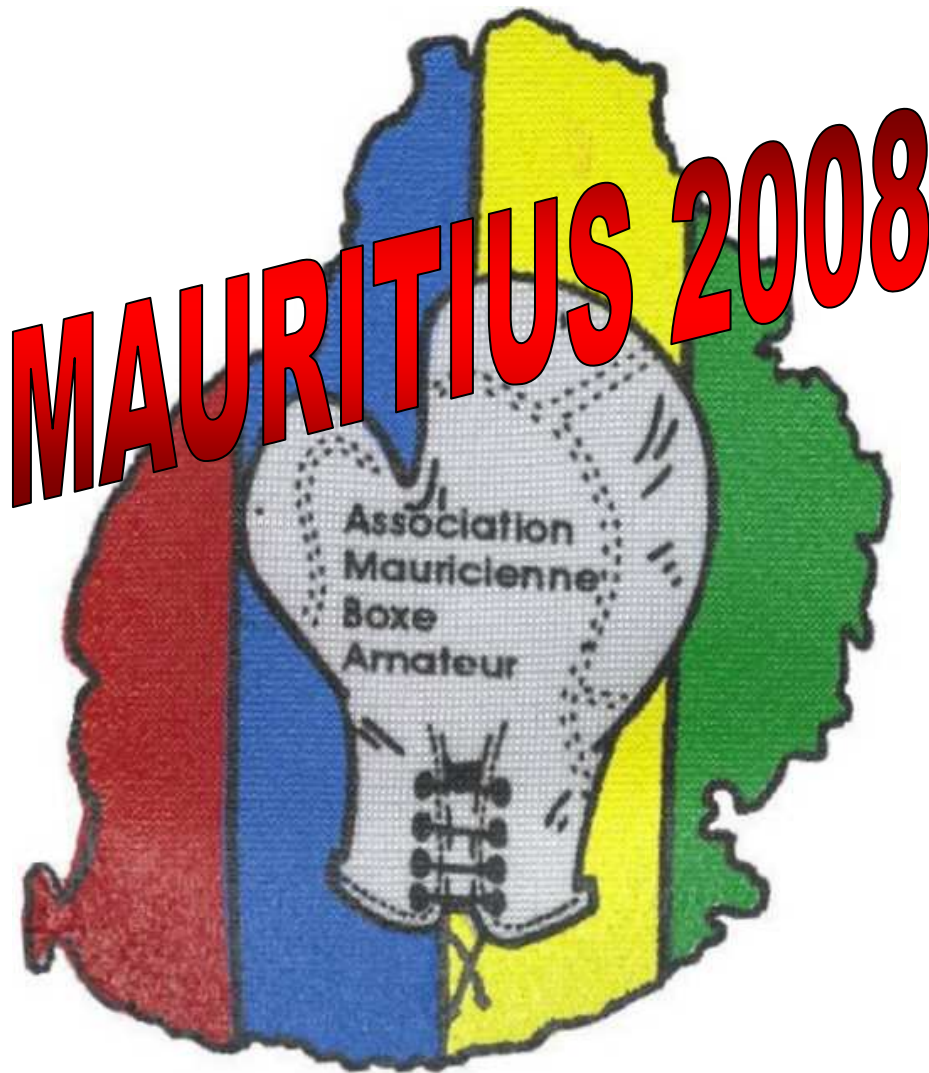

## PARTICULAR REGULATIONS OF AFRICA CUP

### PREAMBULE

Following the orientations of the African Confederation of Boxing, as envisaged in the 2008 activity programme, Mauritius, will host in June 12– 22 2008, in Vacoas, the second Boxing Africa Cup of Nations.

All the African National federations affiliated to ABC and AIBA, up to date with their contributions are invited to take an active part with this historical event in our continent.

This second Africa Cup of Nations organized by the Mauritius Boxing Association, under the aegis and the supervision of the CAB, remains significant in particular for the preparation of the next pugilistic events as:

#### - **The Olympic Games Beijing 2008**

Our country, land of Peace and political stability, is already prepared to organize a warm welcome to all the delegates.

Therefore, this is to settle rules and procedures, conditions of stay and organization of the competition.

### COMPOSITION OF THE DELEGATION

**Article first:** Each delegation will include a maximum of (10) people with a maximum of 6 weight category :

- 1 to 2 boxers 1 official
- 3 to 4 boxers 2 officials
- 4 to 6 boxers 3 officials and 1 AIBA Referee Judge

### CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

**Article 2:** The international transport will be in charge of the participating countries

**Article 3:** The Local transport of the delegations will be in charge of the organizing country

**Article 4:** The board and lodging of the President of AIBA, President ABC, the Secretary General ABC and two Ring Officials (Neutral RJ), will be in charge of the organizing country.

**Article 5:** The expenses for accommodation (3 meals and lodging) of the delegations and Referee & Judge are defined as follows:

- 60 Euros in individual room /person/day.
- 40 Euros in room doubles/ person/day

**Article 6:** All the expenses of participation will be paid upon the arrival of the delegation.

**Article 8:** The delegations arriving before or leaving after the period of the dates will support the additional expenses per day evaluated with 65 Euros per day/person.

**Article 9:** The **Arrival** and **departure** dates **are** respectively planned for June **12-13** and the **22-23** June 2008.

**Preliminaries** 13, 14, 15 June, **Quarter finals** 16 & 17 June 2008, **Semi finals** 18 & 19 June  
**Rest Day** 20 June and **FINALS** 21 June 2008.

**Article 10:** Each delegation is authorized to register only one boxer according to their choice **in one of the 6 categories of weight**. The organizing country reserves the right to engage a complete team.

### **DAYLY ALLOWANCES**

**Article 11:** Each country taking part will provide for all its members, the allowances necessary.

No any prize money other than that envisaged within the framework of the rewards for the finalists will be versed to the participants.

**Article 12:** During the period of competition, the ring official selected will receive an allowance day labourer of 10 Euros/day.

### **MEDICAL CARE**

**Article 13:** All the participants will benefit from the free medical assistance for the wounds caused during the competition

**Article 15:** The delegations being insured in their countries of origin, any other undeclared risk will be the responsibility of the delegation concerned.

### **FLAGS AND NATIONAL ANTHEMS**

**Article 16:** Each delegation is requested to bring two flags of their country and their national anthem recorded on magnetic tape or cd.

### **DATES AND INSCRIPTIONS**

**Article 17:** The preliminary inscriptions must arrive by e-mail or fax, before May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2008, to the addresses mentioned above.

**Article 18:** The final inscriptions carrying the exact composition of the delegations (names, first names, number of the passport) must arrive imperatively at the latest on May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2008. No exemption will be granted.

**Article 20:** The Mauritius Boxing Association reserves the right to refuse a late inscription. It cannot be held, in this case, for person in charge for the expenditure of stay of the delegation concerned.

### **MEDICAL EXAMINATION**

**Article 21:** The medical examination and the official weigh in will take place every morning of the competition.

**Article 22:** The hour of the weigh in is fixed from 8 h and 10h.

**Article 23:** In case of unexpected event, beyond control, the weigh in of the confirmed arriving late will be done 3 hours before the beginning of the bout for the category where this boxer is registered.

**Article 24:** During this competition, before and during the engagements, each boxer will have to provide his AIBA record book in which is mentioned the yearly medical exam.

### **Co-organization**

**Article 25:** This competition hosted by the Mauritius Boxing Association, will be placed under the technical and administrative control of the ABC Office.

### **VISA ENTRY TO MAURITIUS**

**Article 26:** The participating countries are requested to obtain the visas of entry in Mauritius through the Embassy or Consulate of Mauritius in their countries.

**Article 27:** The participating countries which do not have any diplomatic representation may obtain their visas with the international airport Sir Seewoosagur International Airport. These federations have to inform the organizing committee.

**Article 28:** The Mauritius Boxing Association begins to make all the provisions which are essential to facilitate the entry of the participants.

### **AWARDS AND PRIZE**

**Article 29:** All the participants will receive a diploma of participation and the winners, namely the boxers, will be entitled to a Bronze or Silver, Gold medal.

**Article 30:** The finalists will receive a souvenir.

**Article 31:** The three best teams will receive a trophy each one

### **FINAL PROVISION**

**Article 32:** In all the cases, the Second Africa Cup of Nations which Mauritius organizes will unroll in accordance with the regulations of the CAB and the AIBA.
