7. Referees / Judges

AIBA selected 15 neutral Referee / Judges

8. Participating Boxers:

A. Boxers:

Total of 88 invited Boxers will compete. These were selected by AIBA according to the best ranked top 8 (eight) boxers in each weight category. The host nation will present one boxer in each weight category.

B. Number of Coaches:

- 1-3 boxers from the same federation will be allowed 1 coach
- 4 or more boxers from the same federation will be allowed 2 coaches

9. Competition Format:

4 rounds of 2 minutes, 1 minute rest between rounds

10. Boxing Equipment:

The Organizing Committee will provide the boxing gloves, headguards and handwraps to all boxers for all bouts.

Boxers may bring their own headguards, however, these must be manufactured by one of the AIBA Official Boxing Equipment Licensees.

11. Financial Conditions:

A. Boxers & Coaches:

- **AIBA will cover the airline tickets for the boxers, whereas the Organizing Committee will cover accommodations and meals.**
- **AIBA will also invite and cover the airline tickets for one coach for the teams composed of up to 3 boxers and two coaches for up to more than 3 boxers from each federation, whereas the Organizing Committee will cover their accommodations and meals.**

B. Extra Team Officials in Hotel Cosmos:

Each of the extra guests will have to pay:

- **EUR €111 per person, per day, in double occupancy, including the three meals.**
- **EUR €174 per person, per day in single occupancy, including the three meals.**

The acceptance of the extra guests will be subject to availability of rooms, provided these are reserved with the Organizing Committee.

13. Transportation

We kindly ask to all the participant federations to make their arrangements to travel to the **International Airport Domodedovo (DME) or Sheremetyevo (SVO)**, where they will be welcomed by the staff of the Organizing Committee to be transported to the Hotels.

13.2. Local Transportation

The Organizing Committee will provide the local transportation to all the participants between the airport and the hotel and venues (competition & arena).

14. Medical Care:

The organizing committee will provide free Medical care and first-aid for all participants during the entire event.

15. Doping Control:

Doping control shall be conducted in accordance with AIBA Rules and following the World Anti-Doping Code under the supervision of the AIBA Doping Control Delegate. Both urine and blood samples may be collected immediately before, and during, the Championships.

16. Medals:

Gold, Silver and 2 (two) Bronze Medals will be awarded along with diplomas to the winners in each weight category

17. Training Facility:

The Organizing Committee will provide required training facility located at:
Sports Complex "Kryl'ya Sovetov"- 24a, Leningradsky Prospekt, Moscow.

18. Equipment:

- AIBA will provide all equipment with TOP TEN brand
- For gloves, all boxers must use the TOP TEN gloves
- For headguards, the boxers can use other licensed products such as adidas and Everlast. For this case, AIBA will cover the brands

19. Requirements:

- All boxers must bring along with them:
 - Record Book with Annual Medicals duly completed.
 - Passport.
 - Two sets of vests to the venue
 - Red & Blue are not longer a must. National colors can be used
 - each boxer should have dark and light colored team vest (blue & red still permitted)
 - 2 National Flags 1x 1.50 cm>
 - 1 National Anthem (on MP3, CD or Cassette Tape)

20. Visa
