### 6. Rules and Events of Competition:

The event will be held according to the International Competition Rules of AIBA

Age category: Athletes born in 1990 – 1991

Youth in all the 11 weight categories:

Feather Weight	Kg. 57

### 7. Judges / Referees

All the teams can send one R/J, AIBA International.

### 8. Participating Teams:

A. Boxers:

Each federation can send one boxer for each of the above weight categories. One reserve per weight category may be entered. Only reserve athletes that have been entered on the final entry list are allowed as replacement.

B. Number of Team Officials:

Each country can send the following number of officials in their delegation:

- 1 boxer                    1 official
- 2 to 4 boxers            1 coach and 1 official
- 5 to 8 boxers            2 coaches and 1 official
- 9 to 11 boxers          3 coaches and 1 official

### 9. Competition Format:

4 rounds of 2 minutes, 1 minute rest between rounds.

### 10. **Boxing Equipment:**

The Organizing Committee will provide the boxing gloves, headguards and hand bandages to all boxers for all bouts.

Boxers may bring their own headguards; however, these must be manufactured by one of the AIBA Official Boxing Equipment Licensees.

### 11. **Financial Conditions:**

#### A. Team Delegations:

- Each federation is responsible to pay and provide the airline tickets for their athletes and officials from the country of origin to the competition city and return
- Accommodation: The stay of the official Delegations will be provided by the Organizing Committee at a cost of:
  - **USD \$55.00 (Fifty five American Dollars), per person, per day in double occupancy**
  - **USD \$70.00 (Seventy American Dollars) per person, per day, in single room, including the three meals**
- All the participants are required to pay for their accommodation charges before or upon their arrival to the Host Hotel.
- All teams are requested to provide their own travel and medical insurance for this event.

#### B. Extra Guests:

Each of the extra guests will have a cost of:

- **USD \$90.00 (Ninety American Dollars) per person, per day, in double occupancy, including the three meals.**
- **USD \$110 (One hundred and ten American Dollars) per person, per day in single occupancy, including the three meals.**

The acceptance of the extra guests will be subject to availability of rooms, provided these are reserved with the Organizing Committee on the same dates as the closing of final entries.

### **Requirements for the Visa procedure for foreign Athletes:**

1. To send copies of all the pages of the passport, including those pages in blank by courier service or e-mail to [wyboxch2008@asdeporte.com](mailto:wyboxch2008@asdeporte.com) or by fax to +52 55 21 22 30 51, [sdelrio@asdeporte.com](mailto:sdelrio@asdeporte.com)
2. Endorsement letter by the Federation
3. City where the delegation will pick up the visa
4. Date of entry and departure
5. Indication if the person is an athlete, coach or official
6. The procedure will take 40 working days

**The Organizing Committee will guarantee to all the members of the participant delegations all the necessary facilities for the visa procedure to enter Mexico, provided they comply with all the corresponding**

arrangements in due time and form and when they indicate the place Mexican consular representation where the visa will be provided. A critical requirement for the visa is to provide by courier service or by fax, the copies of all of the passports of the Delegation members, from the first page, where the photo appears, to the last page, even if they are blank.

### 13.1. Airport

We kindly ask to all the participant federations to make their arrangements to travel to the **International Airport Miguel Hidalgo in Guadalajara, Mexico, where they will be welcomed by the staff of the Organizing Committee to be transported to the Host Hotel.**

### 13.2. Local Transportation

The Organizing Committee will provide the local transportation to all the participants between the airport and the hotel and venues (competition & arena).

### 14. Medical Care:

The organizing committee will provide free Medical care and first-aid for all participants during the entire event.

### 15. Doping Control:

Doping control shall be conducted in accordance with AIBA Rules and following the World Anti-Doping Code under the supervision of the AIBA Doping Control Delegate. Both urine and blood samples may be collected immediately before, and during, the Championships.

### 16. Medals:

Gold, Silver and 2 (two) Bronze Medals will be awarded along with diplomas to the winners in each weight category

### 17. Training Facility:

The Organizing Committee will provide required training facility. (This information will be provided upon arrival).

### 18. Requirements:

- All boxers must bring along with them:
  - Record Book with Annual Medicals duly completed.
  - Passport.
  - Red and Blue singlet (no other color will be allowed as competition vest in the ring)
- Each National Federation Team must bring
  - 2 National Flags 1x 1.50 cm
  - 1 National Anthem (on MP3, CD or Cassette Tape)
