Suspension of Mr Jae Joon Yoo

I hereby inform you that at the date of this letter Mr Jae Joon Yoo remains suspended from engaging in any AIBA boxing activities at national, continental or international level, including as to assuming his position as President of the Korean Amateur Boxing Federation (**KABF**), in accordance with the second decision of the AIBA Disciplinary Commission of 18 November 2009.

This second decision was upheld by the AIBA Appeals Commission, and is currently being considered by the Court of Arbitration for Sport. However, there is no doubt that while this decision is under consideration by the Court, the suspension remains entirely current and enforceable. The Court itself confirmed this position in a decision issued on 5 February 2010, which expressly rejected an application by Mr Yoo to lift the suspension pending a final determination of the matter.

Accordingly, and in compliance with the undertaking given by the KABF to the AIBA Disciplinary Commission, the KABF remains obliged to acknowledge such suspension and to take action to ensure that Mr Yoo does not act in any capacity within the KABF during the period of suspension. The KABF must not follow the orders or instructions of Mr Yoo and Mr Yoo must be barred from the premises of the offices of the KABF during the period of suspension.

Despite this requirement, I note that I have received preliminary information that Mr Yoo has recently imposed himself into a position of authority within the KABF and has attended meetings organised on KABF premises.

If such information is substantiated by evidence which we are expecting to receive imminently, this office will request that the AIBA Disciplinary Commission commences further proceedings and investigations against Mr Yoo and KABF, alleging that they have collectively failed to respect the terms of the suspension.

If it is determined that KABF has not complied with its obligations and its undertaking to the AIBA Disciplinary Commission, this office will request the AIBA Disciplinary Commission to pronounce further sanctions against the KABF, including but not limited to a suspension of the KABF and its boxers from all AIBA international and continental competitions.

AIBA considers this to be a serious matter. KABF will not be permitted to act in contravention of the decisions of the AIBA Disciplinary Commission and the Court of Arbitration for Sport.
