SUBJECT: AIBA and the Future

Dear Presidents and Boxing Members,

After a long dark and unethical time, AIBA has become a purely trustful and respectful global governing body for the sport of boxing with your full support and invaluable trust.

However, I would like to alert and share that some current ill-intended activities have been going on to damage AIBA and its current administration by a group of persons who have lost their positions and influence within AIBA due to their unchangeable habits of manipulating people for their personal interests and welfares.

These activities have been demonstrated by circulating untruth stories, rumors without any concrete facts and by creating controversy to divide among the boxing family. Sport Intern news agency, Go Soay the Turkish journalist and some leaders in a few National Federations are the ones leading these activities against the new AIBA.

As you can read from the attached letters to all leaders of the Olympic movement, I would also like to seek your support and participation to identify these persons in order to protect our boxers and officials from being negatively influenced. I am sure these activities will further be increased due to the forthcoming AIBA elections toward the end of this year. However, we are the people who like boxers and the sport of boxing. I believe it is time for us to proactively protect our organization and boxing family from these dark rumors and email violence.

We have a good idea of who these persons could be since we all have been receiving emails and communications. They are not ashamed to carry on this harassment since they are desperate as the new AIBA will not have any space for them as long as they do not respect our transparent and clean organization.
