
Dear Presidents, Secretaries Generals and Colleagues,


Chers Présidents, Secrétaires Généraux et Collègues,



4. Competition Venue

- Name: Serhedchi Olympic Sport Complex
- Location: Baku, Azerbaijan

5. Rules and Events of Competition

- The Championships will be held following AIBA Technical & Competition Rules
- Boxers aged between 17 – 18 are eligible to participate to the Championships, thus
 - Boxers born between January 1, 1992 – December 31, 1993, based on their “Year of Birth”
- The Championships will be staged in 11 Weight Categories:
 - 48kg, 51kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 64kg, 69kg, 75kg, 81kg, 91kg, 91+kg

6. Competition Format

- Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes
- One (1) minute rest between rounds

7. Judges / Referees

- All Referees and Judges will be selected by AIBA and all expenses will be fully covered by AIBA
- National Federations cannot send their own R&Js

8. Registration

A. Boxers:

- AIBA affiliated National Federations can send only one boxer in each weight category
- One reserved boxer per weight category may be entered in the final entry form; also, only pre-reserved athletes who have been registered are allowed to be replaced on the day of the General Weigh-In

B. Number of Team Officials:

- Each team can have the following number of officials in their delegation:
 - 1 - 4 boxers: 2 coaches
 - 5 - 8 boxers: 3 coaches
 - 9 -11 boxers: 4 coaches
- In addition, each team may be accompanied by one (1) team manager and/or one (1) doctor and/or one (1) physiotherapist

9. Boxing Equipment

- AIBA will provide boxing gloves, headguards and hand bandages to all boxers for all bouts
- Both gloves and headguards are compulsory official items and all boxers shall wear the equipment provided by AIBA

10. Transportation

A. Airport Reception:

- All participants will be welcomed at the Heydar Aliyev Airport and transported to the Athletes Hotel

B. Local Transportation:

- The LOC will provide local transportation between Hotel, Venue and Training Venues during the Championships Period
- The LOC will also provide local transportation for all departures

11. Accommodation for Team Delegations

A. Room Rates for Team Delegations:

- For double occupancy (2 persons per room)
 - US\$ 60 per person, per day, including 3 meals
- For single occupancy (1 person per room)
 - US\$ 80 per person, per day, including 3 meals
- These room rates are only available during the Championships Period

B. Payment of Hotel Room Charges:

- All delegations must pay the full room charges in advance at the time of check-in
- All delegations will not get hotel room keys if they do not clear the payment in full

C. Check-In:

- The first available date for participating delegations to arrive is April 20, 2010

12. Insurance

- All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance
- The LOC will prepare liability insurance during the competition period for all participants for any incidents taking place inside the Venue

13. Doping Control

- Doping control shall be conducted in accordance with the AIBA Rules and following the World Anti-Doping Code under the supervision of the AIBA Medical and Anti-Doping Sub-Commission

14. Medals

- Gold, Silver and 2 (two) Bronze Medals will be awarded along with diplomas to the winners in each weight category

15. Training Facility

- The LOC will provide required training facilities (information will be provided upon arrival)

16. Requirements

- A. All Boxers:
 - Passport
 - Record book with annual medicals duly completed
- B. Each Team Delegation:
 - National flags 1x 1.50 m of every participating country
 - National anthems (on MP3 or CD) of every participating country
- C. For Preliminary Entry Registration:
 - Complete registration forms (pages 11, 12 and 13)
 - Sending by email of preliminary forms by February 15, 2010

D. For Final Entry Registration:

- Final Entry Registration forms will be provided to National Federations having submitted the Preliminary Entry Forms duly completed

(* Note: Preliminary Entry forms must be signed by the Federation's President or Secretary General

17. Visa

- The LOC will grant assistance to all delegations about VISA matters
- All former USSR countries do not need a visa
