Dear Presidents, Secretaries General and Chairmen of National R&J Commission,

AIBA is very pleased to inform you that 31 National R&J Instructors and 12 International R&J Instructors have now been certified following the AIBA's 1st R&J Instructors Course which took place from February 22 – 25, 2010 in Bécancour, Canada. In this regard, we would also like to clarify their assignments as follows:

- The National R&J Instructors will be assigned to give R&J seminars and training courses for both new and 1 Star R&Js to be held in either their country or abroad, except the examinations
- The International R&J Instructors will be assigned to give R&J seminars and training courses for both 2 Star and 3 Star R&Js to be held in either their country or abroad. These International R&J Instructors will certainly be able to give the examinations and to certify all R&Js in all levels.

Now after the long process of producing these R&J Instructors since the beginning of 2009, we would like to receive your applications to host any R&J seminars, courses and examinations. Once your applications to host these events have been received by the AIBA HQs Office, they will be relayed to the AIBA R&J Commission for its approval.
